Horses, Kentucky Treasures & Victorian Charm

Stroll along Georgetown's picturesque Main Street surrounded by Victorian-era buildings. You'll discover charming antique shops, art galleries and boutiques, local history museum, arts & cultural center, and an eclectic array of dining options. Georgetown is just minutes from the Kentucky Horse Park, a nationally renowned 1,200-acre equine themed park. Enjoy horseback riding and horse farm tours including Old Friends Thoroughbred Retirement Farm, home to Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Silver Charm. Visit nearby Keeneland Race Course. Speaking of horsepower, take a guided motorized tram tour of the world's largest vehicle manufacturing plant and see the remarkable process from beginning to end. Tour Ward Hall, a Greek Revival antebellum mansion. See Noah's Ark up-close with a short drive to the world-renowned Ark Encounter.

KENTUCKY HORSE PARK



This world famous equine park is dedicated to sharing Kentucky's love of horses. Home to the 2010 World Equestrian Games and the Annual Kentucky Three-Day event, the park includes the International Museum of the Horse, a Parade of Breeds, working farm tour, carriage rides, trail rides, special events and shows.

OLD FRIENDS THOROUGHBRED RETIREMENT FARM



Tour the non-profit thoroughbred retirement farm dedicated to providing a safe haven and permanent retirement to thoroughbreds whose racing and breeding careers have come to an end. Home to over 100 horses, visitors can get up close and personal with stars of the turf. Tours are available daily. Reservations Required.

The facility responsible for producing the Camry, Camry Hybrid, Avalon, Avalon Hybrid and Lexus ES 350 presents one of the top 10 industrial tours in America. WARD HALL



This national landmark built circa 1857 is believed to be the largest Greek Revival house in Kentucky and one of the finest in the South. Tour guides describe the elaborate parties of the late 1800s, famed Southern belle Sallie Ward and much more. Tours by appointment. Open April through December.

ARK ENCOUNTER



Approximately 30 miles north, the Ark Encounter is a one-of-a-kind historically themed attraction built to resemble Noah's Ark. In an entertaining, educational, and immersive way, it presents a number of historical events centered on a full-size, all-wood Ark, becoming the largest timber-frame structure in the US.
