

## *Autumn Adventures*

### DAY ONE

#### Afternoon

- Attend the Biwater Farm Fall Festival. Attractions include Hayrides, a Spooky Farm House, Sky High Slide, Bunnyville, Pumpkin Vine Zip Lines, Chutes & Slides, Paintball Target shooting, Miniature Golf, Corn Maze, and a petting zoo.
- In October, attend Keeneland's Fall Meet to witness some of the best horse racing in the state.
- Go on a scenic drive and look at the fall colors. Visit Sadieville with its restored railroad depot and Stamping Ground, named for the buffalo herds that waited impatiently to drink from its spring.

#### Evening

- Have a wine tasting and take a tour at the world class Equus Run Vineyards in nearby Midway.
- In September, attend the annual Festival of the Horse, which celebrates the role of the horse in the history of Scott County. Enjoy live entertainment and concessions.

### DAY TWO

#### Morning

- Peruse the Georgetown College art galleries. Visit the Jacobs Gallery, located in the Anna Ashcraft Ensor Learning Resource Center to take in one of the best contemporary art collections in the state.

#### Afternoon

- Pick your own apples at Evans Orchard. While you're there take the kids to the Evans Orchard Play Area featuring the Jumbo Jumper, Apple Cider Slider, Rat Racers Big Wheel Track, Corn Maze, Swings and Tire Climbs, Corn Bin Play Boxes, Hay Castle and Petting Zoo.
- Take a historic downtown walking tour, offering a unique look at some of the city's outstanding residential and commercial architecture, including over 200 buildings listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

#### Evening

- Go camping at the Kentucky Horse Park Campground. Brave the haunted trail and take the kids trick or treating at one of the Halloween Campouts in October.
