DAY ONE

Afternoon

- Travel north to Williamstown to see the Ark Encounter, a life-sized reconstruction of Noah's Ark. Enjoy lunch at the park's restaurant and meet all of the animals in the large petting zoo.

Evening

- Have dinner at Georgetown's Fava's restaurant, in operation since 1910. A he gathering place for locals and visitors alike for over 100 years, Fava's features classic Southern-style cooking and award winning homemade pies.

DAY TWO

Morning

- Spend your morning meeting Little Silver Charm, the world's cutest miniature horse at Old Friends Retired Thoroughbred Farm.
- Visit Royal Springs Park where Baptist Minister Elijah Craig is said to have made the first batch of Kentucky bourbon. Try a sample of Kentucky bourbon at Bourbon 30 Spirits, located across from Royal Spring Park.

Afternoon

- Travel west to Midway and visit Equus Run Vineyards. Enjoy fine wines and tour the vineyard.

Evening

- Shop at the Main Street's antique shops and boutiques before enjoying dinner at one our fine local restaurants.

DAY THREE

Morning

- Take a walk through Yuko-En on the Elkhorn, the official Kentucky-Japan Friendship Garden featuring primarily native plants blended with Japanese garden principles.

Afternoon

- Visit the Kentucky Horse Park, the world famous Equine Park, home to the 2010 World Equestrian Game and the Annual Rolex Three-Day Event. Enjoy lunch at the Farmhouse Café.
