



Historic Sadieville Geotrail Legacy of the Mules

Note for Geocache Searchers: Be sure to write down the codeword found on the geocache log to the corresponding block on your Sadieville Geotrail passport. Once it is completed, please follow the directions listed on the passport for where to return the passport for a free geocoin.

GCBJ3AY Welcome to Sadieville - Corner of KY Route 32 & U.S. Route 25

Pull off the road at the intersection of KY Route 32 and U.S. Route 25 and head to the pullout here near the guardrail. Look for the white reflector at the right end of the guardrail on the outside of the guardrail facing the road. Pull on the reflector to remove. This is the geocache. The log is located inside of the reflector assembly.

GCBJ3AM Southern Railway Caboose - Main Street, Sadieville

The railroad caboose car is located in the center of town on Main Street in Sadieville. Walk to the end of the railcar and look under the elevated platform corner closest to the wall mural to discover the ammo can. The lock combination for the black ammo can at the caboose is BEAR.

GCBJ3AH Rosenwald School - Angle Avenue, Sadieville

From the railroad caboose car in the center of town on Main Street in Sadieville, turn right onto Church Street. Church Street will turn into Angle Avenue as you head down the hill to Pike Street. About halfway down Angle Avenue you will see the Rosenwald School on your right. To locate the geocache, proceed down the steps to the schoolhouse. Look to the right at the bottom of the steps in the corner. You will see a fake rock that is the geocache.

Veterans Park - 859 Pike Street, Sadieville

Note: There are two geocaches located in Veterans Park - Veterans Park geocache and the final location for the Robert H. Brooks Memorial multi geocache

GCBJ3B3 Veterans Park - 859 Pike Street, Sadieville

From the center of town on Pike Street proceed for approximately 1/2 mile to Veterans Park. From the parking lot, walk past the splash park to the far back corner of the park towards the wooded area. Look under the back corner of the shed on the side closest to the road. You will find the geocache here that is a small Lock 'n Lock container.

GCBJ3AR Robert H. Brooks Memorial - Intersection of Pike Street and Main Street, Sadieville

Proceed to the historical marker for Robert H. Brooks located on the right side of Pike Street. Here you can learn more about Robert H. Brooks.

Note: Due to the geocache located near the railway car just up the street from here, the geocache container for Robert H. Brooks had to be relocated to a different location due to proximity issues with geocaching guidelines. To locate the geocache that is placed in Veterans Park, proceed approximately 1/2 mile to Veterans Park from the center of town on Pike Street. From the parking lot, walk along the walking trail towards the fence in the far-left back corner of the park in the direction of downtown Sadieville. Look straight ahead and you will see a pile of moss-covered rocks. Hidden in the rock pile is the geocache in a Lock n' Lock container.

GCBJ3AB Sadieville Knights of Pythias Cemetery - Cunningham Street, Sadieville

Approaching Sadieville from KY Route 32 from U.S. Route 25 on Sadieville Road, turn right on College Street before the railroad overpass. Turn right on Cunningham Street and proceed to travel uphill until you come to the cemetery. Drive to the back of

the cemetery. Halfway along the curve in the road at the back of the cemetery you will see a large cedar tree. The geocache is a wooden birdhouse under the cedar tree. The lock combination to open the geocache is 131. Be sure to relock the geocache when finished here.

GCBJ3B0 Beard's Cemetery - Intersection of Route 32 and Davis Road and North Dividing Ridge Road, Sadieville

After departing Sadieville, travel east on KY Route 32 (Davis Road) until you reach North Dividing Ridge Road. You will see Beards Church on your left. Turn left on the gravel road right before the church and proceed uphill to the cemetery until the road ends. Begin to walk towards the back of the cemetery until you see 3 angel statues. Look to the fence line on the left behind the first angel and you will see a cedar tree. Look under the cedar tree for a fake rock that is the geocache.

GCBJ3B8 Sadieville Fire Station - 1350 Sadieville Road, Sadieville

Approaching Sadieville from KY Route 32 from U.S. Route 25 on Sadieville Road, turn left onto the fire station property and park in the parking lot on the left side of the building. **DO NOT PARK IN THE FRONT OR ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE BUILDING IN ORDER TO NOT INTERFERE WITH FIRE STATION OPERATIONS.** Proceed up the side set of stairs that are on the side of the building near the parking towards the front of the building facing the road. You will see a birdhouse on the railing near the stair landing. This is the geocache. The lock combination to open the geocache is 530. Be sure to relock the geocache when finished here.

GCBK933 Sadieville Mural - Main Street, Sadieville

Proceed to the Sadieville mural that is located on the side of a building near the railroad caboose car in the center of town on Main Street in Sadieville. Here you can view the colorful mural that portrays the history of Sadieville. Note: Due to the geocache located near the railway car just up the street from here, the geocache container for the Sadieville mural had to be relocated to a different location due to proximity issues with geocaching guidelines. To locate the geocache proceed down Main Street and go through railroad overpass heading towards U.S. 25 (Georgetown Road). Turn left onto Mulberry Street across from the Eagle Bend subdivision sign. Park at the pullout on the side of the road near the guardrail. You will see a No Outlet sign on the right side of the road. Look for a reflector on the post of the sign. Pull on the reflector to dislodge it from the sign. This is the geocache container and the log is located inside the reflector.

GCBK8XH Eagle Creek Boat Ramp - Hinton Sadieville Road

Travel through Sadieville on Pike Street heading east. Turn left onto Hinton Sadieville Road and turn into the Eagle Creek boat access point on the left. Look at the end of the guardrail with the black and yellow stripes. Unscrew the top bolt on the guardrail bracket facing the creek. The geocache is a fake metal bolt and the geocache log is located inside of the bolt.
