Youth Sports: The Scott County Y runs seasonal youth sport classes in pee wee sports, soccer, tee ball, basketball and horseback riding for ages 3-10. Each class is designed using the games approach to introduce and teach participants the basic skills of each sport. In addition, the Y runs leagues in basketball, youth soccer, tee ball and flag football. Leagues typically last 8 weeks with practice one day per week and games on weekends. Volunteer coaches and Y staff are both utilized in running the leagues.

Summer Camp: The Y offers a variety of summer camp opportunities to meet the needs of families and youth in the community. Programs are for children 5-12 and run each full week of summer from 7:15 AM-6 PM. Each week has a different theme that is incorporated into the weekly activities, games and field trips. In addition, the camp goes swimming one day a week.

Specialty Camps: The Y offers Specialty Camps such as Lego Camp and Horseback Camp, in Scott County. These camps are collaborations with local experts in each field to broaden the horizon of the students in the camps. Each camp is unique in design to meet the needs of its campers. Space is limited per week, but multiple sessions of each camp are run every summer.
